

AGREEMENT

on research, educational and cultural cooperation

between

Institute of Mathematics of Julius-Maximilians-Universität Würzburg (Germany)

and

S.P. Timoshenko Institute of Mechanics of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine (Kyiv, Ukraine)

S.P. Timoshenko Institute of Mechanics of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine, represented by the Acting director, Academician Volodymyr Nazarenko, and **Institute of Mathematics of Julius-Maximilians-Universität Würzburg**, represented by Managing Director, Prof. Dr. Frank Werner, (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties"), based on the inter-institutional cooperation and traditions, agree to sign this Agreement on mutual cooperation.

Article 1

The Parties, in accordance with their respective Statutes and within the framework of existing opportunities, shall develop cooperation in various spheres of scientific research, education, and cultural exchange, relying on the principles of equality and mutual benefit. This cooperation shall involve researchers, scientists, students, postgraduates, and other members of the academic and scientific community.

Article 2

The Parties shall organize the exchange of visiting researchers, methodological literature, scientific materials, information, research plans, and programs. This exchange aims to enhance the theoretical and practical knowledge of the participants and promote collaborative research efforts.

Article 3

The Parties shall organize joint research projects on mutually agreed subjects, facilitate the exchange of scientists, and develop direct contacts between departments, laboratories, and other scientific units. The Parties shall inform each other about scientific events, such as conferences, seminars, and workshops, and invite representatives of the other Party to participate in these events.

Article 4

The Parties shall organize the exchange of students, postgraduates, and trainees, providing them with the necessary conditions to expand their theoretical and practical knowledge.

Article 5

Both Parties agree that the most effective form of cooperation is to establish direct relations between interested parties in specific fields of research. Such cooperation shall be based on the interests of specific departments, laboratories, or individual researchers and shall be conducted in a manner acceptable to both Parties.

Article 6

This Agreement does not exclude other forms of cooperation that may be proposed by either Party. Any additional forms of cooperation, amendments, or supplements to this Agreement shall require the mutual written consent of both Parties. Any amendments to this Agreement shall be made with the knowledge and agreement of the participants involved in the cooperation.

Article 7

Both Parties agree that all financial arrangements necessary to implement this Agreement or any subsequent agreements must be negotiated in accordance with the regulations of each institution and will depend on the availability of funds. This Agreement establishes a foundation of mutual understanding and interest but does not entail any financial obligations for either Party.

Article 8

This Agreement shall enter into force upon signature by both Parties and shall remain in effect for a period of 5 (five) years. It may be extended or renewed by mutual written consent of the Parties.
